About LEED

The Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Green Building Rating System is the nationally accepted benchmark for the design, construction, and operation of high performance green buildings. LEED gives building owners and operators the tools they need to have an immediate and measurable impact on their buildings' performance. LEED promotes a whole-building approach to sustainability by recognizing performance in five key areas of human and environmental health; sustainable site development, water savings, energy efficiency, materials selection, and indoor environmental quality. LEED is a registered trademark of USGBC.

About USGBC

The U.S. Green Building Council (USGBC) is a non-profit organization composed of more than 12,000 organizations from various facets of the building industry working to advance buildings that are environmentally responsible, profitable, and healthy places to work and live. In 1995, the USGBC responded to the demand for a definition of "green building" and developed the LEED rating system.

One major misconception, the USGBC certifies products as "green." The USGC does not certify, promote or endorse specific products of individual manufacturers. Actually, it is the construction projects or buildings that may be LEED certified, not the products. The products and installation methods may contribute to earning the required points to achieve LEED certification.
